NOTICE TO APPLICANTS.

The Widows' Pension Law, passed by the Tennessee Legislature, provides for the widows of soldiers only, and they must have been residents of the State of Tennessee for three years before making application.

There are only two classes of widows pensionable

CLASS 1-Is for widows whose husbands died or were killed during the war.

CLASS 2-Is for widows who married prior to 1876.

To be eligible under either class the applicant must have remained a widow after the death of her soldier husband and must be indigent.

Read the questions in the application carefully and answer them fully.

Notice the classification, and unless you come clearly under one of the classes it will be useless to file application.

The Board meets on the second Tuesday in January, April, July and October.
